



2011 EXPLANATION OF SERVICES

Fire Run Farm (FRF) has been primarily established as a private facility; however a limited number of outside horses are included in our training program. In welcoming our newest customers, and for the benefit of our long-time friends who have trained with us for years, we offer the following explanation of services. We hope this will help you understand the services offered by Fire Run Farm.

BOARD & TRAINING

Billed the 25th of each month for the upcoming month, and payable by the 5th of each month. Fees are as follows:

Full time Board & Training - \$1000.00 includes full care with feed, bedding, grooming and full-time training as dictated by each horse's particular needs and abilities. Blanket laundering and routine clipping included. Supplements and medications are billed separately.

Maintenance Board - \$750.00 applies to horses not in full training though requiring occasional supervised exercise or other specific needs (medical layups, temporary 'down time' after the show season, etc.).

Board - \$600.00 includes feed and bedding with occasional turnout.

LESSONS

One lesson per week on your horse is included with full board and training. Additional lessons are available at \$40 per lesson. If you do not have a horse in training, lesson fees are \$50.00 per session.

TACK & SUPPLIES

Training equipment, such as work bridles, bits, harnesses, saddles and jog carts, are a traditional part of a professional's training services and are covered by the trainers at FRF. Then there are other items individually required for each horse. These include a horse's own leather halter (with name plate), blankets and sheets, a bustle, and show equipment such as a bridle, harness and saddle. As these items are needed, FRF will discuss these purchases with the customer prior to purchasing and billing.

VETTING / SHOEING / MEDICATIONS

FRF uses the finest of farriers and veterinarians for the horses in their care. These tradesmen typically bill customers directly for services rendered. On the occasion that FRF is billed for a customer's charge, these charges will be applied to the customer's next invoice with a 20% service charge.

Please note that a customer's payment schedule is a reflection on Fire Run and our other clients and we request that you please pay promptly.

SPECIALTY GROOMING

It is not unusual for a horse to require body clipping throughout the year to insure maximum turnout. This fee helps to cover the cost of the clippers, blades and materials used.

- Body clips \$100.00
- V-Clips \$30.00

FOR THE HORSE SHOWS

Should you have a horse that is ready to compete, here is what will be involved:

ENTRIES

FRF will complete and send in your entries with consideration to the classes for which the horse is best suited. Copies of each horse's registration papers, owner's USEF, AMHA and UPHA cards are required. FRF can easily complete memberships for each of these associations and will bill the customer at cost.

Many major shows now accept credit cards. Because some of these entries may be large in expense, we may ask for a credit card number to complete your entries. All entries are billed at cost.

SHOW EXPENSES

The customer will be billed a daily charge of \$85/day/horse in preparation for, and during the horse show. This charge helps to cover additional caretakers, per diem expenses and show supplies needed to present a horse for the show ring. All other expenses, such as horse transportation, trainers' hotel, airfare, car rental, decorations, bedding and tack stalls will be prorated among the horses attending the show. The customer is responsible for all entry fees (including office fees, horse stalls, etc.) as mentioned above. To owners exhibiting hunt horses; braiding fees will be charged on the next billing statement. Show invoices must be paid prior to departure for the show.

FRF will also have available show equipment which can be 'rented' by the customer on a 'per class' basis as follows:

- Fine Harness \$25/class
- Fine Harness buggy \$75/class
- Pleasure cart \$50/class

TIPS

FRF is fortunate to have some of the best caretakers in the industry. They take great pride in the horses in their care, and during the shows spend 24 hours a day with them to ensure their safety and well-being. Their dedication to each horse is invaluable and we appreciate your help in keeping them a part of our team.

HORSE SALES & PURCHASES

Commissions of 10% will be charged by FRF for the selling of any horse in training at FRF regardless of contact origination.

A commission of 10% is payable to FRF on the purchase of any new horse for a customer when assisted by a FRF trainer.

The customer is responsible for all expenses incurred for marketing of sale horses and also for time and evaluation of prospective purchases.

LIABILITY

FRF's professionalism insures the highest quality of training and care for every horse at our facility. While every precaution is taken for their safety and welfare, Fire Run Farm and its staff can not be responsible for any accidents of nature and is not liable for any injury or loss.

Each customer must agree to and sign a 'Release and Hold Harmless' agreement to Fire Run Farm, its employees and associates, in the event of an accident or injury (*see attached*).

FRF highly recommends, and will assist with, implementing full major medical and mortality insurance for customer's horse(s).

DEPARTURE

FRF sincerely hopes that all its customers, current and new, will enjoy showing horses with us for many years to come. If the association with FRF should end in any way, we truly hope that a positive memory full of rewarding experiences goes with each customer and that they know the door is always open.

We fairly state that horses will gladly be released from the farm upon consent of the owner with all indebtedness to FRF paid in full.
